In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the West Bengal University Act, 2007 (West Bengal Act XXVI of 2007), the Governor is pleased hereby to appoint the 26th day of May, 2008 with effect from which such colleges existing within the limits of the districts of Uttar Dinajpur, Dakshin Dinajpur and Malda in the State of West Bengal as specified in the Schedule below shall be deemed to be affiliated to the West Bengal University and shall cease to be affiliated to the University of North Bengal or any other university to which they may have been affiliated before the said date except any college (Jorhat University college of North Bengal University before the appointment date) subject to the condition that the powers and jurisdiction vested in the West Bengal University of Technology and the West Bengal University of Health Sciences shall not be affected by this Notification.

WHEREAS in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Balurghat B.Ed. College, Plot No.-98, 276 & 517 (P), Vill.-Mongalpur, PO.-Balurghat, Tehsil/Taluka-Mongalpur, Town/city-Balurghat, Dist.- Dakshin Dinajpur, West Bengal-733101 has submitted an application (Code No. ERCAPP1390) to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for conducting B.Ed (Additional Intake) with an additional annual intake of 100 (one hundred) by online on (mm/dd/yyyy) 12/16/2012 and hard copy of application submitted on (mm/dd/yyyy) 12/19/2012.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Secondary Teacher Education (B.Ed) programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to for conducting B.Ed. Course of Secondary (level) of one year duration with an **additional annual intake of 100 (one hundred), thus making the total annual intake of 200 (two hundred)** from the academic session 2014-2015 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

4. The recognition/permission is subject to fulfillment of the following:

- (i) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- (iii) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (iv) All such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.



- (vii) The institution shall submit the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (viii) The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
- Copy of the Application Form
 - Land and Building Particulars
 - Staff Profile
 - Recognition/permission letter
 - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition/permission as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

6. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, they may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days of the issue of the order.
