

Proceedings of the meeting dated 12-09-2018

The Principal and Ex-officio Chairperson of IQAC cell took the chair.

- 1) The meeting started with the explicit consent of the chair and the resolution of the last meeting dated 25-05-2018 was read and confirmed.
- 2) The progress of activities namely integration of value based education with curriculum transaction by Binoy Kr. Goswami, formalization of curriculum revision and the enrichment of the prescribed curriculum by Indrojit Saha, evolution of new practices related to curricular aspects by Uttam Kr. Maji, assessment of the learning level of students after admission and identification of advanced learners by Rabindranath Bar and formalization of remedial Learning were thoroughly discussed (based on their reports), examined and evaluated. The committee thanked them for their devotion to the tasks allotted to them. The teacher members of the IQAC are encouraged to continue their enhancement activities related to internal quality development and perform their related assignments till the achievement of the goals.
